This aircraft was designed and built by the staff and apprentice members of the Halton Aero Club in 1926. Its first flight was on 31 January 1927, piloted by Flight Lieutenant Le Poer Trench. He went on to fly it very successfully in a variety of competitions. It was damaged and broken up in 1930.
